

## UK Grant Funding

**88% of our current grant funding is administered by UK organisations, and 83% of UK funding is held by universities.**

31 UK organisations have been awarded 10 or more awards and received grant funding exceeding £10 million over the past five years. The number and value of these awards (and the award rate) for each of these organisations is shown in the table below.
